
We called and prayed with hundreds of our supporters. So many of you gave very generously to the evangelistic and charitable work that we do.

Intake Goes International

Community Evangelized, Families Baptized

Our missionaries in the Philippines are transforming the community of Isla Bonita, where scores of people are attending their weekly prayer meetings, Bible studies and children's catechism classes, and 36 people were baptized!

Filipino School Transformed

On the island of Camiguin, our missionaries are transforming a school, teaching kids the value of a REAL relationship with Jesus, and bringing 300 students to confession!

To the Ends of the Earth


In Mexico, FMC missionaries are faithfully reaching out to the poor and marginalized, often in remote villages, sharing our faith and meeting their material needs, including our "Stitches of Faith" program—helping the marginalized women of the Km 64 village to find sustainable work sewing liturgical linens.

Stateside Ministry Grows

Here in the US, FMC missionaries have visited the poor in their homes, spoken at retreats, conferences, youth groups, churches and on college campuses.

Floors for the Poor and More

FMC missionaries have reached out in mercy this year, ministering to those who have been affected by typhoons in the Philippines, tornados in Joplin, and hurricanes in New Orleans. The sick have received medications, surgeries, and care, food has been given to the hungry, and shut-ins and prisoners have been visited, cement floors have replaced dirt in over 35 houses, and clothes were provided for those in need, and ALL of it has been done in the Name of JESUS!
